The Budget Commission met in the Governor's office at 5:00 o'clock P. M., all members being present.

The following appropriation transfers were approved by the Commission:

Clemson College (Public Service Activities)

From Extension Service \$3,500.00 to Extension Service - Purchase of Camp Buildings and Equipment.

State Board of Fisheries

From Food Supplies \$150.00 to Repairs.  
From Oyster and Clam Culture \$150.00 to Office Equipment.  
From Travel \$250.00 to Office Supplies.  
From Oyster and Clam Culture \$20.00 to Telephone & Telegraph.  
From Oyster and Clam Culture \$50.00 to Repairs.

State Forestry Commission

From Division of State Parks \$950.00 to Division of Forestry.

Comptroller General's Office

From Disbursing Clerk \$525.00 to Clerical Help.  
From Disbursing Clerk \$150.00 to Settlements Counties.  
From Secretary \$375.00 to Clerical Help.

From Salaries Stenographers Chief and Associate Justices \$393.75 to Special Payments - Stenographic Services.

The following allotments from the Civil Contingent Fund were approved by the Commission:

Mrs. Vivian Shuler for typing in case of State v. Hill \$42.60.

The Code Commissioner \$300.00 for Special Help.

The Governor's Office \$1,000.00 for Special Investigations in connection with Law Enforcement.

In connection with the above allotment of \$1,000.00 to the Governor's Office, Governor Jefferies explained that it would be a considerable advantage in the law enforcement work to have at his disposal the services of a confidential investigator, whose identity was unknown, to handle certain types of difficult cases. This need was fully explained to the Commission by the Governor and the allotment was unanimously granted. The Secretary was directed to arrange with the Comptroller General for funds to be drawn from this account by the Governor's secretary and disbursed under personal direction of the Governor solely for the purpose of such investigations, and that the Commission should be advised periodically as to the details of such expenditures.

A request for \$6,000.00 by the State Board of Health to supplement its current appropriation for County and District Health Work was carried over to a subsequent meeting, and the Secretary was instructed to ask the Board of Health for further information as to the need of this allotment.

A request from the South Caroliniana Library for funds to be used in duplicating certain public records in Charleston and Columbia was carried over for consideration at a subsequent meeting of the Commission.

The Commission then adjourned.
