After reviewing the documents, the counts to which he pled guilty are only Class B misdemeanors, not felonies. In addition, moral turpitude can be summarized as the duty one owes to a fellow man, not to animals. For these reasons, the official is probably most likely not guilty of a crime of moral turpitude.
