As we prepare to close out yet another year, it's a great time to take a moment and reflect on all that Team South Carolina has accomplished over the last 12 months. As far as economic development activity is concerned, we built on the momentum generated in previous years, announcing more than 115 projects in 36 counties.

In addition to the diversity in location, we also recruited a diverse group of industries in 2018. Among the year's biggest wins was RoundPoint Mortgage Servicing Corporation's decision to locate its new corporate headquarters in York County, creating 1,100 new jobs. Illustrating the fact that South Carolina is becoming an increasingly popular destination for headquarters facilities and other office projects , announcements from companies like RoundPoint prove that the Palmetto State is more than just a manufacturing powerhouse.

Speaking of manufacturing, several of South Carolina's top manufacturers saw new facilities come to fruition this year. In June, Volvo Cars opened its Berkeley County facility , unveiling the first-ever, South Carolina-made S60. And, in September, Mercedes-Benz Vans officially opened its \$500 million Sprinter van manufacturing plant in Charleston County.

In retrospect, it's clear that 2018 was another big year for the economic development team across South Carolina. We worked together to bring jobs and opportunities to the people of this state, and I'm excited to see the impact that our efforts will continue to have in the years

to come.
