Hi Chaney and Rob, Julie Pace from The Associated Press here. I'm reaching out about a multimedia project The Associated Press is doing on women in politics. We're interviewing a broad range of women from around the country – both Democrats and Republicans – and we'd love for Gov. Haley to be among them.

The project is pegged to the nation for the first time selecting a women to be the presidential nominee of a major party. The project is NOT about Hillary Clinton herself and most of our questions do not focus on her.
