I'm excited to share with you a brand new publication from the Organization for International Investment, which shows how South Carolina has benefited from foreign direct investment (FDI). Specifically, this report shows how many **jobs in your state** are tied to global investment and includes useful data on their wages and benefits, compared to the state average. When you look at the statistics, I think you will conclude that global investment provides the type of **Jobs We Need**.

Nationally, this new report shows that 24 million U.S. jobs are supported by global investment. Incredibly, that is one in seven private-sector jobs.
