1. On September 8, 1978 at 10:00 a.m., I contacted Mr. Tom Miller of WANS Radio Station concerning the September 12, 1978 Called Meeting of Anderson County Council.
2. On September 11, 1978 at 10:57 a.m., I contacted Ms. Janna Gower of the Anderson Independent and Daily Mail concerning the September 12, 1978 Called Meeting of Anderson County Council.
3. On September 11, 1978 at 11:59 a.m., I contacted Mrs. Sara Liverance concerning the September 12, 1978 Called Meeting of Anderson County Council.

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Mr. Hooper gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the September 5, 1978 meeting as mailed.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to go into Executive Session at 7:07 p.m.

During Executive Session, Mr. Robert P. Lusk gave Council the following legal advice concerning the Tax Assessor's office:

1. That County Council be authorized to appoint an Advisory Board to provide input to the Tax Assessor's appraisal program.
2. That this Advisory Board, if implemented, be responsible of selecting qualified appraisers that are needed to begin the appraisal program for Anderson County.
3. That County Council amend, if necessary, the fiscal year budget of the Assessor's office to provide monies for appraisers in the appraisal system for Anderson County.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to go into Regular Session at 8:25 p.m.

Mr. Robert P. Lusk gave the public and news media a brief discussion of what took place in Executive Session.

On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to set up a nine member Advisory Board for the Tax Assessor's office. Supervisor C. Edward Poore and members of Anderson County Council will each designate one citizen to serve on this Board. These citizens will then designate three additional members to serve. The Board will work closely with the Tax Assessor in setting guidelines, policies, and implementations for the Tax Assessor's appraisal program. The Board will be selected at Council's next meeting on September 19, 1978 at 7:00 p.m.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 8:30 p.m.
