Columbia, SC – Lieutenant Governor Kevin Bryant will discuss today his Anti-Racketeering Ethics Reform Proposal to stop the organized racketeering that has infested the Statehouse for decades. An official press conference detailing his proposal will be held today at the Poinsett Club in Greenville at 11:30 A.M., prior to the Upstate Women's Republican Club meeting .

"The simple fact is that there has been a very organized effort for at least two decades to use the powers of elected office for personal gain," said Lt. Governor Bryant.
