## **Available Beaufort County Area Tourism Statistics**

### **Tourism-Related Taxes**

(Source: SCPRT and SCDOR)

- FY1213 Statewide 2% Accommodations Taxes for Beaufort County were \$6.3M, up 8.0%.
- FY1213 Statewide 5% Admissions Taxes for Beaufort County were \$3.6M, up 3.5%. For the first three months of FY1314 (July-September), Statewide 5% Admissions Taxes for Beaufort County are \$979K, up 0.6%.

### **Hotel Performance Data**

(Source: Smith Travel Research)

- In calendar year 2012, occupancy for the Hilton Head/Beaufort area was at 55%, up 4.7% over calendar year 2011.
- For the first nine months of calendar year 2013 (January through September), occupancy for the Hilton Head/Beaufort area is at 61%, up 4.3% over the same period in the previous year.

### **Estimated Visitor Spending**

- In calendar-year 2012, visitors to Beaufort County spent an estimated \$1.1B which generated over 12,000 jobs and \$95M in state and local taxes.
