The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the State Auditor at 10:00 A. M. on November 18 to consider recommendations for the State Budget for the year 1955-56. Board members Bates, Rhodes and Verner were present, and Governor-elect George Bell Timmerman, Jr.

The Board studied the requests of the departments and institutions and probable revenues that would be available during the current and next fiscal year. The Board then outlined certain policies to be followed in formulating its recommendations and directed the State Auditor to prepare a tentative budget based on these policies. The Board then agreed to meet again on November 23 to consider this tentative Budget.

The Board officially approved a contribution from the Civil Contingent Fund to the Woodrow Wilson Home for painting the Home. 500.00

The Board agreed to pay from the Civil Contingent Fund to Davis, Polk, Wardwell, Sunderland & Kiendl the sum of \$2,033.23 to cover expense in the case of Briggs vs. Elliott.

The Board further approved payment to R. L. Bryan Company the sum of \$12,360.00 to cover the compilation and printing of the 1954 Code Supplement, no appropriation having been made to cover this cost.

The Board then adjourned.
