Hear Hendley

At their regular meeting at the Jefferson Hotel today Kiwanians heard W. S. Hendley, chairman of the Columbia Housing Authority, give a review of the accomplishments of that authority here since its establishment in 1934.

During that period much has been accomplished here, he said, and pointed to the four projects in the city, directed by the authority, Gonzales Gardens, University Terrace, Allan-Benedict Court, and Andrew Jackson Homes.

Mr. Hendley noted the progress of low-cost housing, as well as defense housing in the city, and reminded Kiwanians of the application of this program as a post-war measure.
