- WHEREAS,** through the delivery of preventative care, health assessments, and on-site referral services, the presence of nurses in our schools encourages a healthier environment while educating our children about health and wellness issues; and
- WHEREAS,** school nurses act as a liaison to the school community, parents, and health care providers on behalf of children's health by promoting wellness and improving health outcomes for our nation's children; and
- WHEREAS,** school nurses have served a critical role in improving public health and in ensuring student's academic success for more than 100 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 7, 2014, as
