#### Description/Significant Features:

The house is a wooden frame structure, with a front-gabled roofline. The central door is located beneath a full-width, gabled front porch that is square brick columns on larger brick piers; the porch wraps around the north elevation and has an additional projecting side gable section. There are three single one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl sash windows on the front elevation, two to the north of the door and one to the south. The northern elevation has a one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl sash window and another entry door in the projecting section.
