228th Theater Tactical Signal Brigade Facts

- The 228th TTSB has been preparing for this mission since July 2009.
- Upon arrival in Afghanistan the 228th TTSB will assume the mission of operating, maintaining and expanding the communications network for all U.S. Forces in Afghanistan.
- The Brigade will be based at Bagram Airfield.
- The Brigade will train at Fort Lewis Washington for approximately three weeks prior to deploying.
- 105 Soldiers will deploy for this mission.
- Approximately 40% of the Soldiers in the Brigade have previously deployed in support of the Global War on terror. Many have deployed multiple times.
- 228th TTSB was the first TTSB in the Army to deploy to Afghanistan (2004-2006) where they functioned as the G6 (Signal Command) for CFC-A (Combined Forces Command-Afghanistan).
- 228th TTSB has executed more ODT (overseas duty for training) missions than any other unit in the state, supporting exercises for 5 different Combatant Commands.
- 228th Signal Detachment Soldiers were among the first Soldiers on the ground during Desert Storm.
- Prior to its inactivation in November 2010, the 228th Mobile Signal Detachment (MCD) was the most deployed unit in the Army since Desert Storm with a total of 7 deployments in 9 years.

Plant: The Hartsville Rainbow Operations Plant (also known as the Royster-Clark Plant -- part of the agricultural services for the Agrium conglomerate) in Hartsville, Darlington County. Employs about 60 people. Produces up to 78,400 tons of fertilizer per year.

Incident: Plant caught fire and exploded around 7pm on Monday, 2/14/11, and quickly spread to surrounding woods.

Recovery: No injuries reported. A dozen fire departments from surrounding counties came to help. Fire is still burning. Last night, 73 people stayed overnight in a shelter at TB Thomas Gym. There are no families in shelter at this time.
