Dear Nikki Haley (R),

There is a clear and consistent scientific consensus that our planet is in distress. I am writing to urge you to:

2. Include an equity analysis to ensure that the most-impacted communities see the benefits of lower energy costs, reduced pollution and new jobs.
3. Ensure that our state develops a State Implementation Plan that prioritizes renewable energy and energy efficiency.
4. Ensure that our State Implementation Plan does not lead to an expansion of nuclear energy and natural gas fracking, both of which carry their devastating environmental costs.

Our state should be at the forefront of creating a new, green economy and leaving our children a clean, sustainable planet.
