WHEREAS, the loss of a child, whether born or unborn, is a traumatic and heartbreaking event for families who recognize that even the shortest of lives are valuable; and

WHEREAS, Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month calls attention to the need to recognize the grief and honor the courage of families who have lost an unborn or newborn child.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 2015 as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to remember children lost during pregnancy or as infants and their families.
