It was a pleasure speaking with you today and thank you so much for your time.

Even though the Governor will not be able to attend the school weatherization service project in Bamberg tomorrow, I was wondering if she would be able to meet with me at some later date about the Conservation Voters of South Carolina Green Schools Initiative.

As a background, this initiative began about a year ago through a small grant from the Emily Hall Tremain Foundation in CT. We aim to improve the learning environments of rural areas that are often overlooked along the I-95 corridor. Projects such as Saturday are just the first steps for these schools. We have also partnered with companies across SC willing to help out by offering their time to complete energy audits and reports, as well as donated or reduced priced lighting, HVAC systems, etc. Such improvements can create MAJOR savings

in these schools and districts which can then be allocated to books, computers, more teachers...

I would love to speak with her further about this initiative and get some advice/support if she would be available.
