

DPS FY14-15 Budget

Local Law Enforcement Grants:

- \$300,000 recurring
- \$800,000 non-recurring
- General Assembly sought to fund projects for local agencies such as Mobile Data.
- Mobile Data was fully funded for DPS in the FY14-15 budget.
- DPS did not request the funding for local agencies.

Advantages of Mobile Data for local agencies would include:

- Allow local agencies to participate in the Electronic Tickets and Warnings with DPS.
- Allow local agencies to participate in the Electronic Collision reporting system.
- Electronic Collision reports would allow the local agencies to transmit the reports to DMV faster and more efficiently. This reduces paper processing by DMV employees.
- DPS provides all local agencies ticket and warning books. A local agency using electronic tickets and warnings reduces expense and administrative processing to DPS.
- Allow local agencies to have immediate access to SLED databases for criminal record checks.
- Allow officers to spend less time on administrative duties and more time on enforcement activities.
- Increase efficiency in submitting tickets to the court systems thereby decreasing administrative costs for the court system and the local agency.

- Non-Recurring Purchases
 - In-Car Laptop Computers
 - Vehicle Computer Mounts
 - In-Vehicle Printers
 - Driver's License Scanners
- Recurring Purchases
 - Air Card Data Service
 - Software Maintenance Fees
