Subject: Jurisdictional Survey Report

The IM Subcommittee conducted detailed telephone interviews with each U.S. jurisdiction from February 22 through March 25, 2005. The responses to these telephone surveys have been detailed in a report. The goal was to assist AAMVA and its membership in determining the current status of jurisdictions on their efforts to implement the measures of the Security Framework.

After additional updates from the membership the survey report has been completed and is ready to be released to the membership (only). In addition we have developed an "executive summary" version of the survey report with only generic information and no jurisdiction specific information. This version will be made available to AAMVA's associate membership.

The goal is to make the reports available on AAMVA's web site later this week.
