Historical Information: The memorials wer erected at the entrance to the Agricultural Society of SC's experiment station office where work on Sea Island Cotton production took place. Samuel G. Stoney was president of the society from 1909 to 1926, when he died a it was decided to memorialize his contributions to the society with a plaque on one of the posts.
