**Residents of Section to
Get City Delivery; Sub-
station Planned**

The Edgewold postoffice, in operation for many years at 2305 Taylor street as a third class postoffice, will be discontinued and residents of that section, including Gonzales Gardens, will get city delivery service March 1.

Columbia's postmaster, E. C. Goza, said the area served by the Edgewold office was practically surrounded by city delivery service.

Residents of the section, who formerly had to go to the office for mail, will now have it delivered to them.

The postmaster of the Edgewold office, Mrs. Mary E. Seibert, will become a regular clerk at the main Columbia office.

Two substitute carriers of the Columbia office, Dupree L. Gunter and Jack Beaman, get promotions to regular work as result of the change.

Mr. Goza said McCauley's drug store would probably receive a contract to operate a substation in the area. The station will offer all postal services except delivery.
